Kenya's Nairobi, Maasai Mara, & Mombasa

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE Transportation to & from airport not included.

Monday - Sept. 17, 2012

(Transportation and dinner included.)

Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and transfer to the Tribe Hotel, one of Condé Nast Traveler's hottest resorts. Those of you on a morning flight can relax or shop for arts and crafts at the Village Market next door. Once the entire group has arrived at the hotel, we will meet for evening cocktails for the official launch of our Kenyan adventure.

Tuesday - Sept. 18, 2012

(Meals, entry tickets, transportation included.)

After breakfast, our adorable animals tour stops at the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust for orphaned elephants, then it's off to the Giraffe Centre to feed giraffes! Afterwards, it's lunch at the Karen Blixen Coffee Garden and a traditional dance performance before returning to the hotel to relax and change for a night of dinner and fun.

Wednesday - Sept. 19, 2012

(Meals, transportation, park entry fees included.)

Leaving the bulk of our luggage in storage, we take a small bag on a flight to the Maasai Mara National Reserve. Our destination: the delightful Mara Serena Hotel, but first a detour for our first wild game drive! Then back to the hotel for dinner and bedtime. On the savanna, it's early to bed and early to rise to catch the most exciting animal action.

Thursday - Sept. 20, 2012

(Meals, transportation included. Hot air balloon ride not included.)

To see the Great Migration on a grander scale, take to the air in a hot air balloon! It's a thrilling alternative complete with champagne breakfast. At the hotel, we'll meet members of the Maasai Tribe who will perform and teach us their moves. That afternoon, we venture out again—how many different animals will you see?

Friday - Sept. 21, 2012

(Meals, transportation included.)

One last trip into the savanna and then we fly Nairobi to pick up our luggage, then we're off to Mombasa, the sparkling Indian Ocean, and the Sarova Whitesands Beach Resort & Spa. After some fine dining at the Lido Seafood Restaurant, it's salsa night at the Coco Beach Bar!

Saturday - Sept. 22, 2012

(Meals, transportation, classes included.)

Take part in a late morning lesson learning dances of the coastal tribes. Pamper yourself in the spa or enjoy the welcoming waters of the Indian Ocean. The day is yours to enjoy. Tonight another delicious meal and more entertainment by acrobats or live bands.

Sunday - Sept. 23, 2012

(Breakfast, dinner included.)

The entire day is free for relaxation! Fish, swim, sleep or chill out in a hammock by the sea. Or, if the shopping bug has you, visit the Bombolulu Workshops & Culture Centre, where world renowned disabled artists create beautiful arts and crafts. In the evening, we gather for our farewell dinner. Last chance to party!

Monday - Sept. 24, 2012

(Breakfast, lunch, transportation included.)

From breakfast, we fly to Nairobi. There, we enjoy some final sightseeing and shopping at the Utamaduni Craft Centre for a diverse array of beautifully handcrafted goods. Then it's back to the airport for our flights home and the conclusion of our call to the wild.
